RESOLUTION NO. 14-2023

A RESOLUTION BY THE CHEROKEE COUNTY, KANSAS BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
ADOPTING AN EMERGENCY OPERATION PLAN

WHEREAS K.S.A. 19-101 et. seq., and K.S.A. 19-212 authorize the Board of County Commissioners to transact all Cherokee County business and perform all powers of local legislation deemed appropriate, and to make all contracts and do all other acts in relation to the property and concerns of the County, necessary to the exercise of its corporate or administrative powers.

WHEREAS Cherokee County, Kansas maintains a disaster agency responsible for emergency management and coordination of response to disasters. K.S.A. 48-929(a).

WHEREAS Cherokee County, Kansas is required to prepare and keep current a disaster emergency plan, hereinafter referred to as the "Emergency Operation Plan" or "EOP", for the area under its jurisdiction, which has been approved after examination and periodic review by the Kansas Division of Emergency Management, hereinafter referred to as "KDEM". K.S.A. 48-929(d).

WHEREAS Cherokee County, Kansas has drafted an EOP to establish policies, guidance, and procedures to provide elected and appointed officials, administrative personnel, various governmental departments, and private and volunteer agencies with the information required to function in a coordinated and integrated fashion and to ensure a timely and organized management of the consequences arising from emergencies and/or disasters.

WHEREAS Cherokee County has submitted a proposed EOP to KDEM and such review was completed on November 17, 2023.

WHEREAS KDEM has found the proposed EOP is compliant with the Kansas Planning Standards to include SARA Title III, ADA compliancy, and NIMS requirements.


NOW THEREFORE the Cherokee County Board of Commissioners hereby resolves:

Section 1. The Emergency Operation Plan submitted to KDEM and approved on November 17, 2023 is hereby recognized by Cherokee County, Kansas and directs all personnel involved assume the roles and responsibilities and take appropriate actions as outlined therein.






