## ADMINISTRATIVE RESOLUTION NO. 13-2017

AN ADMINISTRATIVE RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CHEROKEE COUNTY TREASURER TO CLOSE THREE COUNTY FINANCIAL ACCOUNT FUNDS THAT ARE INACTIVE, NO LONGER USEFUL, OR HAVE BECOME OBSOLETE IN CONDUCTING COUNTY BUSINESS.

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CHEROKEE COUNTY, KANSAS, THAT THE FOLLOWING ADMINISTRATIVE RESOLUTION BE ADOPTED:

**SECTION 1.** GENERAL AUTHORITY. K.S.A. 19-101 *et. seq.*, and K.S.A. 19-212 authorize the Board of County Commissioners to transact all County business and perform all powers of local legislation deemed appropriate, and to make all contracts and do all other acts in relation to the property and concerns of the county, necessary to the exercise of its corporate or administrative powers.

**SECTION 2.** PROJECT. The Cherokee County Treasurer, upon the advice and assistance from the County's contracting accountant, shall close the following accounts: Stateline Road Project Account # 105; Community College Account # 170; Landfill Account # 310, by transferring remaining fund balances into County General Account # 100.

**SECTION 3.** ADMINISTRATION. The Board of County Commissioners of Cherokee County, Kansas, directs the Treasurer to transfer fund balances from Stateline Road Project Account # 105; Community College Account # 170; Landfill Account # 310, into County General Account # 100, and to close the three affected accounts.

**SECTION 4.** That all resolutions, County policies or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed insofar as they conflict herewith.

**SECTION 5.** This resolution shall become effective upon passage.
