MINUTES FOR OCTOBER 7, 2013

BOARD OF CHEROKEE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

CHEROKEE COUNTY, KANSAS

CONVENE

Commissioner Hilderbrand called the regular session of the Cherokee County Board of Commissioners (The Board), to order and led all in attendance in the Pledge of Allegiance at 9:00 AM on Monday, October 7, 2013 in the Commission Room, #109 of the Cherokee County Courthouse located at 110 W Maple St., Columbus, Kansas. Commissioners Richard Hilderbrand, Charles Napier, Pat Collins, and County Clerk Rodney Edmondson were present.

Mayor Mel & Laura Greene - Proclamation

Laura Green read a proclamation from Mayor Mel Greene declaring October as National Arts & Humanities Month in Columbus.

Commissioner Napier made a motion proclaiming October as National Arts & Humanities Month in Cherokee County. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Collins. The motion carried 3-0 with all voting yes.

They also stated that October 19th from 5:00 PM - 8:00 PM is the grand opening of the Arts Festival at the Uncommon Hotel.

A motion was made by Commissioner Collins to approve the Minutes of the September 30, 2013 BOCC Meeting as written. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Napier. The motion carried 3-0 with all voting yes.

Leonard Vanatta - Road Supervisor

He reported that cleanup is in progress for the marathon, crews have been working around Rainbow Bridge.

He reported that KDOT again turned down the request to replace the bridge located east of Columbus out by the cemetery.

He provided a quote for a used backhoe to replace the one that Paul uses. It's been repaired about 5 times at a cost of \$4,000 each time and CAT says the breakdown will happen again.

A motion was made by Commissioner Collins to purchase a used 580SN Case Loader Backhoe at a cost including trade-in of \$61,900 to be paid out of the Road & Bridge fund. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Napier. The motion carried 3-0 with all voting yes.

Leonard stated that the bridge on NW 120th at Deer Creek is finished and can be opened to traffic now.

Department Heads - Monthly Reports

They met with the Board for their routine monthly meeting with the following Department Heads present: Barbara Bilke, Register of Deeds; Betha Elliott, Health Department; David Groves, Sheriff; Juanita Hodgson, Treasurer; Nancy Herrenbruck for Kim Lauffer, Appraiser's Office; Nathan Colman, Attorney; Ralph Houser, Maintenance; Rodney Edmondson, Clerk; Wayne Elliott, 911 Addressing & Mapping; Cecil Brown, Noxious Weeds; Deana Randall, Human Resources; Leonard Vanatta, Road & Bridge.



Barbara Bilke - provided a written report to the Board. Passports are still being processed and the government shutdown hasn't affected the process of issuing passports.

Betha Elliott - Reported that the flu vaccine isn't coming in as fast as they would like. She hopes to have their entire 800 doses sometime this month. County employees will be free again when they get the vaccines.

Cecil Brown - nothing new.

David Groves - He reported that KHP just got a new radar system and donated 7 old units to Cherokee County. That's about \$15,000 - \$20,000 in value. A \$105,000 COPS grant was awarded for a School Resource Officer. They hope to have that position filled by Thanksgiving. The next drug take back is October 26th. They want to do a coat drive for new or gently used coats in conjunction with the take back program. The Architect will be here tomorrow to get with Ralph about security plans and will make a presentation to the Board soon.

Deana Randall - The open enrollment for optional life insurance including spouses is open until November 15th.

Jason Allison - He was absent, doing fire safety week at the schools.

Juanita Hodgson - She reported that in three weeks they will get busy with real estate tax statements. She was notified last Friday that the Drivers Exam Station in Baxter Springs will be closing soon. The State is coming here to work her station at the Courthouse on Thursday's and Friday's for full service driver's license needs.

Nancy Herrenbruck - Presented the Board with a correction to a parcel for a barn that isn't there anymore. She also presented a written report from Appraiser Kim Lauffer.

Nathan Coleman - He reported that the Kansas Attorney General was here and hosted a continuing legal education for prosecutors in this district. There were ten other prosecutors in attendance.

Ralph Houser - Nothing to report.

Rodney Edmondson - Reminded everyone that the SEK Officials Meeting will be held in Sedan on October 17th.

Wayne Elliott - His office sold \$45 in maps last month, and issued three new addresses. They are in the process of making property ownership maps within the cities.

At 10:30 AM the meeting left the Courthouse and took a tour of the State Theater with Mike and Janelle Bowman. The tour was open to all that wanted to attend.

At 11:30 AM the meeting returned to the Commission Room.

Kevin Cure - County Counselor

He appeared before the Board on legal matters concerning Cherokee County.

He presented Resolution 27-2013 authorizing the next tax sale for the Board to review. There are 137 properties to be sold.

A motion was made by Commissioner Hilderbrand to pass Resolution 27-2013 authorizing a Real Estate Tax Foreclosure Sale. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Napier. The motion carried 3-0 with all voting yes.



Commissioner Hilderbrand made a motion for a Clerical Correction on a parcel of land removing a farm structure that isn't there, as requested by the Appraiser's Office. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Collins. The motion carried 3-0 with all voting yes.

Commissioner Collins made a motion to allow the Chair to sign off on paperwork from Russell Shipley. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Napier. The motion carried 3-0 with all voting yes.

Commissioner Hilderbrand made a motion to pay \$300 for advertising for Columbus Days. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Collins. The motion carried 3-0 with all voting yes.

Commissioner Hilderbrand made a motion to recess for lunch. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Collins. The motion carried 3-0 with all voting yes at 12:25 PM.

The meeting reconvened at 1:25 PM.

Chairman Hilderbrand signed the 2014 Cherokee County Extension Counsel Budget with a county appropriation in the amount of \$200,615.

Commissioner Hilderbrand made a motion to adjourn until the next regularly scheduled meeting set for October 21, 2013 at 9:00 AM. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Collins. The motion carried 3-0 with all in attendance voting yes at 1:43 PM.

The Board will not meet October 14th, due to the Columbus Day Holiday.

RESOLUTION NO. 2 - 2013

AUTHORIZING REAL ESTATE TAX FORECLOSURE SALE

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CHEROKEE COUNTY, KANSAS:

- 1. That K.S.A. 79-2801, provides that in all cases in which real estate has been or shall be sold and bid in by the County at any delinquent tax sale and shall remain unredeemed on the first day of September, of the second year after such sale, or any extension thereof as provided by subsection (b) of K.S.A. 79-2401a, the Board of County Commissioners shall order the County Counselor to institute an action in the District Court, in the name of the Board of County Commissioners, against the owners or supposed owners of such real estate and all persons having or claiming to have any interest therein or thereto, by filing a petition with the Clerk of said Court.
- 2. That the Board of Commissioners of Cherokee County, Kansas, have been advised by the Cherokee County Treasurer that there are approximately 137 tracts of real estate which have been sold and bid in by Cherokee County at previous delinquent tax sales, and which remained unredeemed on the first day of September of the second year after such sale, and are currently unredeemed.
- 3. That the Cherokee County Counselor be and is hereby ordered to institute an action in the District Court of Cherokee County, in the name of the Board of Commissioners of Cherokee County, Kansas, against the owners or supposed owners of such real estate, and all persons having or claiming to have any interest therein or thereto, by filing a petition with the Clerk of said Court to enforce the lien for unpaid taxes of Cherokee County, Kansas.
