MINUTES FOR JANUARY 7, 2013

COLUMBUS, KANSAS, CHEROKEE COUNTY

OFFICE OF THE COUNTY CLERK

The Cherokee County Commissioners met January 7, 2013. Those present were Commissioners Richard Hilderbrand, Pat Collins, and Jack Garner. The Pledge of Allegiance was said by all present. Commissioner Collins made a motion to approve the commission minutes for December 17, 2012 as presented by County Clerk Crystal Gatewood; his motion was seconded by Commissioner Garner with Commissioners Garner, Hilderbrand, and Collins voting in favor. Commissioners Garner, Hilderbrand and Collins, and County Clerk Gatewood signed off on the minutes.

EXECUTIVE SESSIONS HELD BY COMMISSION

Counselor Cure requested an executive session for Attorney/Client Privilege to discuss Penn Gaming with the commissioners. Commissioner Collins made a motion to go into Executive Session for Attorney/Client Privilege to discuss the Penn Gaming suit for ten minutes with himself, Commissioners Garner and Hilderbrand, and County Counselor Cure; his motion was seconded by Commissioner Garner with Commissioners Garner, Hilderbrand, and Collins voting in favor. They went in at 11:45 AM and returned at 12:05 PM.

OTHER BUSINESS

Road and Bridge Supervisor Leonard Vanatta and the commission discussed general road and equipment maintenance in the county.

Commissioner Garner made a motion to put the names of the four attorneys in a hat and draw one name to fill the position of the Court Appointed Attorney; his motion was seconded by Commissioner Collins with Commissioners Garner and Collins voting in favor and Commissioner Hilderbrand voting no because he did not agree with the procedure. Janitor Ralph Houser drew one name out of the box and Melanie Bingham was appointed.

Doug Mogle, the representative for the Cherokee County Ambulance Association, discussed the two ambulances being purchased through a grant with the commission. It was decided that the County Counselor would write a Lease Purchase Agreement for the new ambulances, and payment for the ambulances will be sent with the county's Account Payables for January 2013.

The Ambulance subsidy for Columbus and Galena will be reduced to \$1,000.00 for the next six months and they are going to be titled by Cherokee County. The new ambulances will arrive January 10, 2013.



Jean Pritchett submitted two Tourism Grants, one for the 150th Anniversary Encampment of Quantrill's Raid at Baxter Springs being held October 4th thru the 6th, 2013, and one for the Snowball Classic Basketball Tournament being held in Columbus, Kansas from January 26th thru March 3, 2013. Commissioner Collins made the motion to approve the grants submitted by Mrs. Pritchett; his motion was seconded by Commissioner Garner with Commissioners Garner, Collins, and Hilderbrand voting in favor. A copy of both grants is attached to these minutes. Mrs. Pritchett also submitted the 2013 Tourism Budget to the commission and it is also attached to these minutes.

Larry Hyatt of the Columbus News Report, and Machelle Smith of the Galena Sentinel asked about the raises for county employees and the bonuses that workers at the County Lot received in December 2012. They were questioning when the commission made that decision to give the raises and bonuses because it was not discussed in open meeting, neither at the December 17, 2012 meeting nor at any other meeting. The only open meeting raises were discussed was when Joni Henry of the Treasurer's Office asked about a raise for Cherokee County Treasurer Juanita Hodgson and no decisions or discussions were forthcoming by the commission. A copy of the voucher submitted by the commission is attached.

The Cherokee County Department Supervisors and Elected Officials gave their monthly reports to the commission.

Jason Allison of Emergency Preparedness spoke about some grants he was working on.

County Attorney Melanie Bingham reported they were working on the transition for the newly elected County Attorney.

Brenda Clugston of the County Health Department submitted grant forms and Commissioner Hilderbrand and County Clerk Crystal Gatewood signed off on the documents.

County Clerk Gatewood reported that the office is working on the 2013 City and School Elections and working on end of the year reports for the county.

Register of Deeds Barbara Bilke reported her office was going well and they are busy.

Sheriff David Groves reported everything was going well and they are currently working to digitize their records.

County Appraiser Nancy Herrenbruck reported that her office is working on getting the 2013 values completed and asked the commission to allow for overtime for her employees.

Deana Randall of Human Resources reported she was working on end of the year reports and January 2013 Mid-Month Account Payables which need to be submitted by January 8, 2013 at noon.

Janitor Ralph Houser discussed the windows for the courthouse and that he was doing some painting.



Wayne Elliott of 911 Mapping & Addressing reported his office sold \$214.00 in maps in December.

Commissioner Garner made a motion to adjourn at 12:20 PM; his motion was seconded by Commissioner Hilderbrand with Commissioners Garner, Hilderbrand, and Collins voting in favor. The next Cherokee County Commission will be held January 14, 2013 in the Cherokee County Courthouse at 9:00 AM.

Snowball Classic is heading into its 15th year. The only advertising that has been done has been on the website with is \$35.00 per quarter on Yahoo, though this year we are producing an event program in which advertising has been sold.

This year our goal is 115 teams in 6 grade divisions. In 2012 there were 109, 2011 totaled 98 teams, 2010 produced 94 teams, 2009 had 89 teams.

Each team pays a \$125.00 entry fee to participate in at least 5 games. The majority of that pays for referees & medals. There is a \$3.00 adult admission, \$1.00 student admission & free entry for under school age. And a concession stand is maintained.

The games are played at the 3 gyms in Columbus, 3 gyms in Cherokee & the gym at Spring River Mental Health in Riverton. In the past, games were also held in Weir.

For each weekend, there are different non-profit groups or organizations that supply workers for the weekend. Those groups receive half of all the gate money & half of the concessions money after the supplies are deducted. The remaining moneys remain with the tournament. Any remaining concession items are donated to various entities like the school districts, etc.
