#### **MINUTES FOR APRIL 14, 2014**

#### BOARD OF CHEROKEE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

#### CHEROKEE COUNTY, KANSAS

#### **CONVENE**

Commissioner Hilderbrand called the regular session of the Cherokee County Board of Commissioners (The Board), to order and led all in attendance in the Pledge of Allegiance at 9:00 AM on Monday, April 14, 2014 in the Commission Room, #109 of the Cherokee County Courthouse located at 110 W Maple St., Columbus, Kansas. Commissioners Richard Hilderbrand, Charles Napier, Pat Collins, and Susan Jones of the Clerk's Office for the purpose of taking the minutes were present. County Clerk Rodney Edmondson is in Wichita for a week long certification class.

Members of the press present: Larry Hiatt, Machelle Smith, and Shawnda Qualls

Chairman Hilderbrand welcomed the students and staff from the Weir Elementary School. The students lead all in attendance in the Pledge of Allegiance.

#### Leonard Vanatta - County Road Supervisor Gene Langerot - County Lot Supervisor

They appeared before the Board on routine county road business. Leonard reported that the bridge project on Hwy 166 is finished and the highway is open for traffic. Gene reported that the new fuel pumps have been installed and are working fine. Gene made a recommendation to accept the bid from S&H Farm Supply for a new tractor.

Chairman Hilderbrand made a motion to accept the bid from S&H Farm Supply for a new tractor at a cost of \$66,925 on Gene and Leonard's recommendation. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Napier. The motion carried 3-0 with all voting yes.

#### Jess Larison - B.A.C.A. (Bikers Against Child Abuse)

They appeared before the Board at their invitation in honor of April being Child Abuse Prevention Month. They provided the Board with cards and flyers and read their organizations Mission Statement. Their purpose is to make themselves available to visit children that are victims of abuse, by invitation only. All members are non-paid volunteers and must pass background checks prior to being made a member. Their meetings are open to the public on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of each month at 1:00 PM at the American Legion in Pittsburg. They invited the Board to attend anytime. The Board thanked them for the work that they do.

The Board took a five minute recess at 9:55 AM.

The meeting reconvened at 10:02 AM.

A motion was made by Commissioner Collins to approve the Minutes of the April 7, 2014 BOCC Meeting as written. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Napier. The motion carried 3-0 with all voting yes.

Deputy County Clerk Paula Cheney appeared before the Board to provide an update on the Regional Officials Meeting set for April 24<sup>th</sup>. The Board discussed speakers, meeting places and transportation for the Commissioners to tour the Spring River Water District.

A motion was made by Commissioner Collins to approve the Mid-Month Accounts Payables for April, 2014. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Napier. The motion carried 3-0 with all voting yes.

Chairman Hilderbrand stated that County Counselor Kevin Cure had faxed the contract with American Title Co. to do all the research for the next County Tax Sale for the Board to consider.

A motion was made by Chairman Hilderbrand to accept the contract with American Title Co. to do title searches for the County Tax Sale. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Napier. The motion carried 3-0 with all voting yes.

#### Betha Elliott - Health Department

She appeared before the Board along with representatives from CDL Electric Co. Inc. regarding installation of a generator at the Health Department to cover the computers, telephones, and appliances during a power outage. The Board approved Betha's recommendation to install a 48K Generac Generator and additions from CDL Electric Co. at a cost \$33,753.14.

#### Juanita Hodgson - County Treasurer

She appeared before the Board to discuss the anti-virus software renewal with Stronghold Data. They pointed out that if the county signs the contract with Stronghold, the anti-virus fees are included in the contract costs.

The Board discussed the proposals from Corporate Business Solutions and Stronghold Data with the county employees and officials that were present.

A motion was made by Chairman Hilderbrand to accept the Contract for IT Services with Stronghold Data with strong encouragement for customer service. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Napier. The motion carried 3-0 with all voting yes.

Under Sheriff Terry Clugston appeared before the Board with a quote to replace a repeater at the Law Enforcement Center. It would be purchased using 911 Funds. The Board signed the purchase order. He also presented a maintenance agreement for the dispatch voice recorder to be paid from 911 Funds.

#### Brian Hilliar - Benefit Health Advisor

He appeared before the Board along with members of the Health Insurance Committee, to provide an update on the county Health Insurance Plan. He reported that costs are down about 8% compared to the same period last year. This was the second year in a row that costs are down for the same period. The Aetna network is providing an average discount of 35.4%.



The Board thanked him for the items that were donated for the upcoming regional meeting.

Commissioner Hilderbrand made a motion to adjourn until the next regularly scheduled meeting set for April 21, 2014 at 9:00 AM. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Napier. The motion carried 3-0 with all in attendance voting yes at 12:07 PM.

It has been our observation that wounded children having the benefit of a B.A.C.A. presence in their lives are far more likely to disclose their abuse. We help in the child's healing process to restore self-worth and confidence.





B.A.C.A. was founded by John Paul "Chief" Lilly.

"Chief" is a Licensed Clinical Social Worker, Registered Play Therapist/Supervisor, and Part-time faculty at Brigham Young University. The majority of his twenty plus years of practice has been spent in the treatment of abused children.

"Chief" was aware that the "System" offered much in the way of helping a child's healing process, yet, there were still shortcomings and limitations to keeping the children safe.

Even with Court involvement to protect children from further abuse by the issuance of protective orders and the removal of perpetrators from neighborhoods, it is physically impossible for law enforcement officials to provide protection for these children twenty-four hours a day, indefinitely. Child perpetrators are fully aware of this and continue to find ways to access and further harm their victims.

Many children that are abused do not qualify for therapy funding. Reasons vary, but the most common are: cases that did not meet the basic requirements of the rules of evidence, and are summarily closed or a child that has obviously been abused and is too frightened to provide enough evidence for the case to be pursued. "Chief" notes that children who feel safe and protected are more capable and likely to tell the truth regarding their abuse because threats made by an abuser are offset by the presence of dedcated protective bikers that have now become family.


