Voter Registration

You may register to vote at the following location during their regular business hours: Monday-Friday 8:00am to 5:00pm. at the county clerk election office located at 110 W. Maple St, room 131 Columbus, KS 66725, and online at www.kssos.org, Department of Motor Vehicles; SRS offices, etc.; U.S. Mail (request Kansas Voter Registration Application by mail or telephone); also available in Online Voter Registration;

www.voteks.gov - Click on Register to Vote and follow directions. A citizen of the United States who is eighteen (18) years of age and upwards or will have attained the age of eighteen (18) years at the next election, must register before he or she may vote.

When a voter has been registered according to law his or her registration shall continue to be valid until one of the following occurs:

1. The Voter changes residence, outside of his/ her voting precinct boundary.
2. The Voter fails to vote in two consecutive state general elections

If either of the above occurs, you must re-register. Any person may apply in person or by mail to the County Election Officer to re-register. The application shall be signed under penalty of perjury.

Advance Voting by Mail: K.S.A. 25-1123

Any registered voter is eligible to vote by Advance Ballot, beginning Wednesday October 19, 2022 (20 days prior to said General Election). Monday, November 1, 2022, is the last day voters may apply for Advance Ballots for General Election per K.S.A.25-1122(e)(4). Applications for Advance Ballots are available at the Cherokee County Clerk's Office or by calling (620) 429-9563. A printable application for an Advance Ballot is available on the Kansas Secretary of State website www.kssos.org.

Returning Advance Ballots:

In person ballots must be returned by 7:00 P.M. on Election Day to any Polling Location within the County or to the County Election Office, County Courthouse, 110 W. Maple ST, Columbus, KS 66725. By Mail: Ballot must be postmarked on or before Tuesday, November 8, 2022 (Election Day) and received in County Election Office by Monday, November 14, 2022, the deadline for receipt of Advance Ballots. K.S.A. 25-1132.

Early Voting:

Early voting (In House/In Person) is available at Cherokee County Courthouse (Clerk's Office) Monday-Friday from 8:00am to 5:00pm beginning Wednesday October 26, 2022, thru Monday 12:00 Noon, November 7, 2022. K.S.A. 25-1122(g)

Per K.S.A. 25-2908 "All Voters must provide Valid Photo Identification (Drivers' License, Military ID, Kansas College ID, Kansas ID or other qualifying ID card) to Vote."
